Select Health has two free health plans, of which are benefits and services. It also offers coverage for children who do not have medical insurance and whose families earn too much to qualify for Medicaid, but not enough to afford a private health insurance plan.

“We have a free nurse line health available 24 hours a day every day, seven days per week, if you cannot contact your doctor, you can always reach the nurse line help,” said Gregory Torrales, Community Event Coordinator at Select Health.

In addition to providing medical services, Select Health is working on an ambitious project, which consists of the development of a community center (First Choice Community Center) which would bring comprehensive services for residents of the area who need information about the local community resources.

“We are in the process of creating the community center. We are really happy because we have the location and the resources to make it work, we are only waiting to gather all the organizations to start this project that will help thousands of Hispanics in the Columbia area and around,” explained Torrales.
