Effective July 1st!

- Zero copays for Medicaid members
 - In accordance with South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (SCDHHS) requirements, Select Health has moved to zero copays for all Medicaid members, effective **July 1, 2024**.
- SCDHHS's preferred drug list (PDL) SCDHHS's PDL was effective July 1, 2024, for Healthy Connections Medicaid members. More information can be found on the pharmacy section of SCDHHS's website.
- \$ \$30 incentive for correct coding of sports physicals Starting July 1, 2024, primary care physicians can earn an additional \$30 incentive payment for accurately and appropriately coding a child's sports physical (age 5-18) with an Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic, and Treatment visit. Quality Corner

Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS) is a widely used set of performance measures developed and maintained by the NCQA. Select Health's Quality department is pleased to share changes to HEDIS diabetes measurements:

- 2024 changes to existing diabetes related HEDIS measures
 - NCQA reassessed how the existing measures identified individuals with diabetes. The new
 measures simplify and mitigate inclusion of individuals who take diabetes-related medications
 for reasons other than diabetes (e.g., weight loss) by adding a diabetes diagnosis requirement
 in the pharmacy method.
 - Glycemic status assessment for patients with diabetes (GSD, formally hemoglobin A1c)
 - Blood pressure control for patients with diabetes (BPD)

- Eye exam for patients with diabetes (EED)
- Kidney health evaluation for patients with diabetes (KED)
- Statin therapy for patients with diabetes (SPD)
- Diabetes monitoring for people with diabetes and schizophrenia (SSD, SMD)
- Emergency department visits for hypoglycemia in older adults with diabetes (EHD)
- Review your monthly HEDIS reports available in NaviNet https://navinet.net.
- Ask your account executive about monthly Quality meetings and data exchange.

Benefit Update Reminders

In accordance with SCDHHS guidelines, the following benefits were added to coverage for First Choice members.

- South Carolina Department of Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse Services (DAODAS) providers

 Effective immediately, SCDHHS allows county substance use disorder providers to enroll as physician
 group providers. The county authority must separately enroll as a physician group provider to bill for
 services on SCDHHS' physician fee schedule which are not currently available in the DAODAS fee
 schedule. Once enrolled, physician group providers should submit all claims for services listed on the
 physician fee schedules under the Medicaid identification number assigned to the physician group. You
 can find instructions on how to enroll as a physician group here on the SCDHHS website.
- Continuous glucose monitoring (CGM)

Effective July 1, 2024, SCDHHS is expanding its existing coverage for CGM coverage to align with the most recent Centers for Medicaid & Medicare Services coverage guidelines and the American Diabetes Association recommendations as follows:

- Type 1 diabetes mellitus
- Gestational diabetes
- Type 2 diabetes with one of the following:
 - Any type of insulin dependency
 - Non-insulin treated diabetes who have recurrent moderated (Level 2) or at least one severe (Level 3) hypoglycemic event.
- o Primary care, ob-gyn, and endocrinology providers may prescribe CGM.
- o CGM will be allowed through the durable medical equipment and pharmacy benefit.
- o Prior authorization is required for Select Health members.

Foster Care

A reminder of the importance of initial well visits for children and youth in foster care:

- When a child enters foster care, they must have an initial well visit preferably within 7 days but no
 longer than 30 days of entering care, as well as at least 2 well visits per year as determined by age.
 - Under 6 months old: Monthly
 - o 6 months to 2 years old: Every 3 months
 - 2 years old and older: Every 6 months
- Select Health will cover the well visit even if the child received one earlier in the year.
- Use 99358 Code with UA modifier, which is defined as "initial visit with patient in foster care" by SCDHHS. This code should be submitted along with the appropriate E/M or well visit code for the direct patient care component, which provides reimbursement for the non-direct care activities associated

with an initial visit, such as record collection and coordination with various providers and state agencies.

Did you know that if a child comes in for a sick visit and is also due for a well visit, you can combine both visits? Well-child visits on the same day as sick-child visits for members from birth to age 21 can be billed using modifier 25.

Effective July 22, 2024, as part of our continued dedication to supporting providers in our shared commitment to high quality health care for our members, no prior authorization or medical necessity review will be required for the following Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System codes.

Reminder: Prior authorization - Current Procedural Technology (CPT) online lookup tool

You can easily determine if a service requires <u>prior authorization</u> by using the CPT lookup tool on our website. No need to call – using the CPT lookup tool is as easy as 1-2-3!

- 1. Enter a CPT/HCPCS code.
- 2. Click the submit button.
- 3. The tool will indicate if the service requires prior authorization as of the day queried.

Change Healthcare update: Remittance advice payment recovery details now available!

Select Health is pleased to inform you that a solution has been developed in collaboration with Change Healthcare/Optum to provide payment recovery details on the remittance advice or 835 you receive with your payments for claims processed on and after May 6, 2024.

For claims processed February 21, 2024, through May 5, 2024, Select Health has generated a comprehensive claims recovery report available in the <u>NaviNet provider portal</u>. The claims recovery report provides payment recovery details by member account number, claim number, provider tax ID, payee/group ID, and NPI.

To access the claims recovery report:

- Log in to the NaviNet provider portal.
- Choose **Select Health of South Carolina**.
- Go to Report Inquiry, under Workflows for this Plan.
- Click on Administrative Reports>Claim Recovery Report.

Beware of Phishing Scams — Don't Take the Bait!



One of the biggest information security risks for most organizations occurs when an associate opens a phishing email and clicks on the link. It takes only one associate clicking a phony link to impact an organization's cybersecurity efforts.

Why it's important:

Phishing scams are emails that look real but are designed to steal important information. A phishing email with malicious software can allow cybercriminals to take control of your computer and put protected health information (PHI) and personally identifiable information (PII), as well as a company's confidential and proprietary information, at risk.

It may be a phishing email if it:

- Promises something of value (e.g., "Win a free gift card").
- Asks for money or donations.
- Comes from a sender or company you don't recognize.
- Links to a site that is different from that of the company the sender claims to represent.

- Comes from a trusted business partner that has experienced a security incident. All emails sourcing from outside your organization should be scrutinized.
- Asks you for personal information, such as your username and password/passphrase.
- Includes misspelled words in the site's URL or subject line.

If you suspect an email may be phishing, here are some tips:

- Do not click any links in the email.
- Do not provide your username and password; you should never share your username or password, even if you recognize the source. Phishing scams frequently mimic well-known companies, such as retailers (like Amazon) or banks.
- Do not reply or forward the email to anyone within your organization.
- Familiarize yourself with your organization's process for reporting suspicious emails. If you suspect an email is a phishing attempt, report it immediately.
- Your organization's information security department may have additional information and guidance on how to protect yourself from phishing scams.

NaviNet Provider Portal

The NaviNet provider portal is a valuable resource to help providers manage administrative functions, including checking eligibility, reviewing HEDIS and quality reports, verifying other insurance information, and submitting prior authorization requests.
