

Are you trying to quit?



First Choice would like to help our members quit smoking.

How?

First Choice covers medicines to help you stop smoking.

What items are available for First Choice members?

Nicotine gum, nicotine patches, Welbutrin, Zyban and Chantix (tablets).

How long are they covered?

We cover several stop-smoking products for a limited 90-day period of time.

How do I get them?

All stop-smoking products need a prescription. Make an appointment with your doctor to discuss the right method for you. Once you get a prescription, you or the pharmacy can contact First Choice for approval.

How often can I get a prescription?

Once you fill the first prescription, the clock starts your 90-day benefit. After that, you will have to wait 9 months before First Choice will approve another 90-day benefit.

In some cases, you may need to request an override if you have reached your monthly prescription limit.
